## **Guelph Dance presents Dasein Dance Theatre at our next CSA NOONER**

**Guelph, ON** (Nov 13, 2012) – Throughout the year, **Guelph Dance** presents several productions and co-productions outside our annual 4-day Festival. The **CSA Nooner**, co-presented with the **University of Guelph Central Students Association**, is one such event.

On **Wednesday, November 21**, at **12pm**, the student hub of the University Centre Courtyard, University of Guelph, will be transformed by **Dasein Dance Theatre**. Dasein will perform excerpts from three of their pieces: **Emergence** (2012); **Unframed Portraits** (2007); and **Unsettled Dust** (2011). Choreographed by **Lacey Smith**, these evocative pieces push the body to its limits to reflect the human experience.

Our Guelph Dance co-productions greatly enhance our outreach efforts by exposing dance to a diverse and broad audience, and providing excellent performance opportunities and exposure for dance artists.
